They would then take pictures before/ during practices verses having picture night for the whole organization. The final pictures would be handed back out one after the pictures had been taken. Steve stated that he was willing to give back 10% to BYBA and each coach would receive a free team picture. The Camera Shop, Dixie Suski, and John Linhoff sent packages for us to review. We stated that we would notify each representative within the week regarding the picture project.

Travel League Tournaments:

Mike Hultgren introduced Robyn Dingmann. She has volunteered to help organized the volunteers for the tournaments and set up a schedule. She will also notify people and coaches of the volunteer times.

January tournament

Saturday 17th of January is the boy's grades 4th thru 5th tournament. We need to start shifts at 6 am and then the last shift is over at 8 pm. So the shifts would either be from 6 am to 1:30 pm or 1 pm to 8 pm. Sunday January 18th is the girl's tournament and it should run from 7 am to 4:30 pm. We need to have volunteers to keep the brackets updated, score boards, score keeper, concession stands, money table, and roamer, set up concessions and then tear down the concessions, set out orange ice water buckets, clean up crew for the field house, etc. We would like to see that all parents who volunteer receive their checks back when they are done with their shift. Both Mike and Robyn have stated that they would be around to set up on Saturday morning. All board members present have stated that they would be at the tournament both Saturday and Sunday.

If we use all the parent volunteers that we have and still need people to run score clocks and books, we need to contact Regan Anderson and Paul Lindsey for varsity team members to fill in those openings. We would then donate \$5 toward the varsity program for each game a varsity member keeps score or runs the clock.

Action: Find someone who has access to enlarge the brackets. (Owner: Mike H. ASAP)

Action: Do we have all the referees lined up for the January tournament? (Owner: Sandy, ASAP)

Action: Email all coaches to make sure that all emails were correct for coaches and team managers. (Owner: Laura, ASAP)

We do remember to turn on the ice machine Friday night so that there is ice ready for the tournament.

Mike had a running total of all the teams entered in the tournaments. Both boy's and girl's 4th grade tournaments are full. The 5th grade boy's tournament is also full. He has stated the need for 1 or 3 "C" teams for the girl's tournament. The 6th grade girl's tournament is full. The 6th grade boy's would like at least 6 "C" teams or 3 "B" teams. The 7th grade girl's could use couple of "A" teams and 1 more "B" team. The 7th grade boy's could use a few more "B" or "C" teams. The girl's 8th grade could use 1 more "B" team. The boy's 8th grade has 7 total teams. Mike was going to work on this section. He shows that the total income from just the team part is \$13,650.00 for 2009. Mike and Laura were going to work together to fill some of those slots for the tournament.

Trophies and medals were also discussed. For the 4th and 5th grade tournaments, everyone who participates should be awarded a medal. In an eight team tournament, 1st, 2nd, 3rd and consolation champ trophies should be awarded and everyone else should be awarded medals. In a six team tournament, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies should be awarded while 4th, 5th, and 6th place should be awarded medals. We are having three eight team tournaments in 4th grade girls, 4th grade boys, and 5th grade "B" boys. We would need 10 medals per each team with around 5 extra. For the January tournament, we would need 2 sets of trophies consisting of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and consolation champ and then one set of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies. The trophies in the past have just stated Becker Tournament and the Year. We would like to spend less than \$3,300 for trophies. We are looking at around 180 medals and then trophies.

Action: Find trophies and medals for the tournaments. (Owner: Donna, ASAP)

Action: Print off copy of score sheet one per game. (Owner: Laura, ASAP)

Youth Night:

The nights set aside for youth are as follows: February 13th for boys and February 24th for girls.

We are looking at finding another vendor for the mini basketballs that we give out to the youth during Youth night.

Action: Ask BYSA to sponsor the youth night handouts. (Owner: Michael, January meeting for BYSA)
